The Public Works Department at the Town of Woodstock, NB is hiring an **Equipment Operator 1**, based out of the Public Works and Utility office/shop in Grafton, NB. This role reports to the Director of Public Works & Director of Utility, based on the respective project or worksite assignments. This is a unionized position with wages and benefits as set out in the Collective Agreement between the Town of Woodstock and CUPE Local 719.

This team plays a key role in maintaining critical town infrastructure and assets such as roads, sidewalks, and public spaces. If you are a self-motivated, team player who takes pride in successful execution and tangible results, this is a great opportunity.

JOB DUTIES, SKILLS AND QUALIFICATIONS

- Previous training and industry related experience that demonstrates the ability to competently and safely operate the following pieces of equipment:
 - Tractor (Ford) and all attachments
 - Asphalt roller
- Willing and able to perform the duties of a Labourer as dictated/required by operational needs
- Lift up to 50 lbs to shoulder height; with occasional repetition
- Perform physically demanding labour related tasks for at least 8 hours per day for 5 consecutive days in various weather conditions, which could include frequent and sometimes repetitive pulling, pushing, reaching, standing and/or walking
- A valid, unrestricted Class 3 driver's license preferred, with consideration of a class 5E (with air brake); a current driver's abstract must be submitted with the application. The abstract and claims history must demonstrate safe and reliable driving to meet standard liability insurance coverage requirements, as dictated by the provider
- A valid Standard or Emergency First Aid Training & CPR certificate would be an asset
- Commitment to promote a safety-first culture with an understanding of health and safety regulations and practices with additional training as necessary
