

Youth Council Code of Conduct - Town of Woodstock

Purpose:

The purpose of this Code of Conduct is to provide guidance for all members of the Youth Council, ensuring that members act responsibly, respectfully, and collaboratively while contributing to the growth and development of their community. By adhering to these standards, we aim to create a safe, inclusive, and productive environment where youth voices are heard, valued, and respected.

1. Respect and Inclusion
